- 2. The Crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (other than those in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep)
- 3. Only date of birth indicated in SSC/Secondary School Leaving Certificate/Birth Certificate will be accepted. No subsequent request for change shall be granted.

4. Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility conditions mentioned in advertisement. The candidate would be admitted to various stages of the recruitment process based on the information furnished by the candidate in his/her application. Only a summary scrutiny of the application would be made before the final stage of the recruitment process and detailed scrutiny of the eligibility of the candidate would be done only at the final stage of the recruitment process. As such, the candidature of the applicant shall remain provisional till detailed scrutiny is undertaken and the candidate is found eligible in all respect. RRCAT would be at liberty to reject any application at any stage of the recruitment process if the candidate is found ineligible for the post. The decision of RRCAT shall be final in deciding the eligibility of the candidate.
